MEMORANDUM FOR Commanders, TRADOC Installations

SUBJECT: Personnel Security Clearances for Advanced Individual Training

1. References:

c. Memorandum, HQDA ODCSINT, DAMI-CH, 19 Feb 99, subject: Personnel Security.

2. Reference 1a is hereby rescinded.

3. Reference 1b provides information and guidance to installations on processing trainees in security hold status. Reference 1c provides adjudicative guidelines for determining eligibility for access to classified information.

4. Initial entry trainees having known major derogatory information and having enlisted into one of the following MOSs will be considered security holdovers at BCT installations. The following information is provided:

13R	I-S required by Week 4
14 Series	I-S required by Week 2
96B	I-S required by Week 1 and Interim-Top Secret (I-TS) w/SCI by Week 12

96H	I-S required by Week 1
96R	I-S required by Week 5
96U	I-S required by Week 1
97B	I-S required by Week 1 and I-TS w/SCI by Week 10
97E	I-S required by Week 5
98C	I-TS w/SCI required by Week 1
98H	I-TS w/SCI required by Week 5



5. These trainees will remain at BCT installations until a U.S. Army Central Personnel Security Clearance Facility (USACCF) Letter of Intent is received (reference 1b) or a favorable security clearance determination has been made by USACCF (reference 1c).

6. MOS 98XL may ship to DLI for language training. MOS 98G (Heritage Speakers) may ship to Goodfellow AFB, TX for additional language and military subject training.

7. Soldiers reclassifying into another MOS requiring a security clearance may not ship until the appropriate clearance requirements for that MOS have been met.
